Promoting positive behaviour choices are the main focus of Positive Behaviour for Learning at Chalmers Road School. Students are supported to make these choices through actively participating in high quality educational programs at school.

These programs embed the *Give Me 5 Rules* across all key learning areas and form a consistent school wide approach to learning appropriate social behaviours across contexts. Students are empowered with skills to be successful communicators in the environment.

Students have been involved in creating the learning context behind the *Give Me 5 Rules*, including singing and recording the school song, creating posters promoting the rules and using the visual support tools to demonstrate the rules in action, providing them with a sense of ownership of their rules in their school.
